JASTA AND RECIPROCAL ACTIONS

Before Congress voted to pass JASTA, more than 40 top foreign policy experts warned of the legislation's unintended consequences. Many believed foreign countries would take reciprocal action against the U.S. and its allies, placing officials, diplomats and soldiers at risk. To date, almost 90 countries have issued statements condemning JASTA and warning of its impact on sovereign immunity. Now, the U.S. is starting to see these warnings come to fruition.

Retaliatory action against JASTA is beginning to bubble up around the globe.
