Dear Ms. Belin:

Your application for Registered Press Senate Reserved Work Space has been received. As stated on the application form, the lowa Senate is no longer "credentialing" media as the lowa Capitol Building is a public building open to members of the general public. The public may observe floor debate in the Senate in the Senate galleries or via the Internet. Applicants will only be granted Senate Reserved Work Space if they meet the criteria set out in the Senate Reserved Work Space Policy. Your application has been reviewed and it has been determined that you do not meet the criteria to be a "member of the media" under the Senate Reserved Work Space Policy. As such, you will not have a work space reserved in the Senate Chamber.
