Summary of Recanvass

On February 10th, the Pete Buttigieg and Bernie Sanders campaigns properly submitted requests for recanvass of caucus results. The requests included:

^{*}The Buttigieg campaign request included a spreadsheet of 57 precincts, however 3 were duplicate entries

The IDP Recanvass/Recount Committee [hereafter referred to as the Committee] granted both requests in full.

The Committee named three Recanvass Administrators to conduct the recanvass:

- Staci Appel
- Paula Martinez
- Melissa Peterson

The recanvass began at 9:00 am February 16, 2020. All campaigns were invited to send up to 2 representatives. Present were the Recanvass/Recount Committee, Recanvass Administrators, IDP legal counsel, representatives of the Sanders, Buttigieg, and Warren campaigns.

During this meeting, the Administrators considered and reviewed 81 precincts, including 3 satellites. You can review the full list here.

In total, 29 results were changed as a result of this recanvass.

- 26 changes were because the precinct misapplied the rules according to the DSP
- 3 changes were due to the caucus math worksheet not matching what was reported on the IDP results page.

Below you will find the types of issues requested for review and the number of issues that were changed from how they were originally reported.

^{**} The Sanders campaign withdrew one requested precinct prior to the recanvass beginning.

^{***}In-state satellites were requested as a group by the Buttigieg campaign. The Administrators resolved them as 1 group, the resolution being that the reason for the request was outside of the scope of a recanvass. These numbers therefore are not reflected in the results.

The resolution of the recanvassed precincts are categorized as follows:

- Awarding Delegates Rules Application: in cases where the caucus misapplied caucus rules, the recanvass administrators applied the proper rules
- Viability: in cases where the caucuses miscalculated viability, no changes were made. The administrators deemed that to do so would result in the disenfranchisement of caucusgoers
- **Data entry**: in cases where the public report did not match the Math Worksheet, the public results were update
- **Attendance**: in cases where the 2 alignments did not equal or did not match the attendance used to record viability, no changes were made

After all the precincts were reviewed, the committee adjourned around 3:30 pm.

After a re-tabulation of the new results, no change in the National Delegate allocation occurred.
