VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL

Vote at home to **practice social distancing and help slow the spread of COVID-19.** See form below. County Auditors can begin mailing absentee ballots on October 5. Your Absentee Ballot Request must be received by your County Auditor **no later than October 24 at 5:00 PM CT.**



VOTE ABSENTEE IN PERSON

Vote in your County Auditor's office where **social distancing and safety measures will be in place.** In-person absentee voting is available **October 5 - November 2. REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR ID!**



VOTE ON ELECTION DAY

Vote in your polling place where **social distancing and safety measures will be in place.** Polls will be open **7:00 AM - 9:00 PM on November 3.** Visit voterready.iowa.gov to find your polling place and **REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR ID!**

VOTING ABSENTEE BY MAIL

1. If you already have submitted an Absentee Ballot Request for the November 3 General Election, you do not need to send another one.

2. Read the instructions on the back side of the enclosed Absentee Ballot Request, **provide all the necessary information, and be sure to sign it.**

In order to receive an absentee ballot for the November 3 General Election, you **MUST** provide the following information: (1) Name; (2) Date of birth; (3) Iowa residential address; (4) Voter Verification Number (ID Number); (5) The name **OR** date of the election for which you are requesting an absentee ballot; (6) Signature.

The **Voter Verification Number (ID Number)** is either your Iowa Driver's License or Non-Operator's ID Number **OR** the four-digit Voter PIN located on your Iowa Voter ID Card. **Any Voter may request an Iowa Voter ID Card or Voter PIN by contacting their County Auditor's Office.**

3. Detach the edge of the Absentee Ballot Request marked with "DETACH THIS FORM. INSTRUCTIONS ON BACK."

4. Detach the postage-paid envelope, insert the completed and signed Absentee Ballot Request, and seal the envelope which is addressed to your County Auditor.

5. Place the sealed envelope in the mail as soon as possible to ensure enough time for your ballot to be mailed to you. The **Absentee Ballot Request must be received by your County Auditor no later than Saturday, October 24 at 5:00 PM CT** if you want to receive a ballot by mail.

6. Follow the instructions to vote and return your ballot when you receive it in the mail from your County Auditor.

7. Track your absentee ballot request and absentee ballot at voterready.iowa.gov.

ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUEST FORM INSTRUCTIONS

A registered voter may make written application to their County Auditor for an absentee ballot. A written application for a mailed absentee ballot must be received by the voter's County Auditor no later than 5:00 p.m. 10 days before a General Election or 1.1 days before any other election.

In order to receive an absentee ballot, a registered voter **MUST** provide the following necessary information:

1. Name
2. Date of birth
3. Iowa residential address
4. Voter Verification Number (ID Number)
 - Iowa Driver's License or Non-Operator ID Number **OR**
 - Four digit Voter PIN located on the voter's Iowa Voter ID Card
 - **Any voter may request an Iowa Voter ID Card by contacting their County Auditor's Office**
5. The name **OR** date of the election for which you are requesting an absentee ballot
6. Party affiliation - only required for Primary Elections, which are held in even numbered years
7. Signature

All voters are encouraged to provide their phone number and/or email address in the event their County Auditor needs to confirm any information on the request form.
