Jim Mowrer Joins Board of Directors for Taking the Hill

DES MOINES, Iowa – Iraq War Veteran, former Congressional candidate, and former Vice Chair of the Iowa Democratic Party Jim Mowrer has joined the team at Taking the Hill as a member of the Board of Directors. Mowrer returned to Iraq in 2009 as a civilian analyst and adviser to the commander of U.S. forces. In 2010, during the Obama administration, Jim served as Special Assistant to the Under Secretary of the Army, working in the Pentagon to create the Army Office of Business Transformation and represent the Army before the Council of Governors. Returning to his home state of Iowa in 2014, Mowrer was a Democratic Congressional nominee in 2014 and 2016.
