AT A GLANCE PROGRAM STATUS TRACKER

OKTA: The OKTA contract has been executed by OCIO and pilot testing for OKTA has been completed. As of September 24, 2020, all internal agency systems have been configured to share user credentials with the OKTA platform. OCIO has configured OKTA to integrate with Workday and several other applications successfully. The remainder of the OKTA funding will be paid by November 30, 2020.

Workday: Workday is currently in the Configuration and Prototype stage of the Human Capital Management (HCM) phase. In this stage the business areas develop the configurations of the various HCM business processes. The project team is completing unit testing of configuration changes and preparing for End to End testing which will begin in December. Foundation Data Model for Finance has been established. The Financials project team is also beginning to design the various functional aspects of financials operations within Workday.



Broadband Grants: The contract negotiation phase is underway or just concluding for providers following the Notice of Intent to Award (NOIA). Currently an estimated five providers have agreed to terms of the contract and payments are being processed to go out potentially next week.

Ray Room Technology: The RFP for the Ray Room Technology upgrade to make it easier to live stream information to Iowans has been awarded. Equipment has been ordered with the intent of receiving the equipment and installing by December 1, 2020.

GOV 0365 Conversion: Conversion is underway to update GOV analytical needs. Funds have not been released for the project.

COVID Continued FY2021 Support: The funds have been allocated for technology infrastructure support and upgrades, however funds have not been expended. These are pending until the Governor decides on the proposed use of these funds with other CARES funding requested.
