With Workday, the State of Iowa will be able to act quickly to create new leave types for FMLA and automate processes for donating leave, requesting COVID-related hardship donations, and borrowing leave. Onboarding and off boarding of employees can be performed by remote, quickly and easily.

State employees will use Workday to request telecommuting capabilities and all internal forms and approvals will be generated and signed through Workday, which will allow for easier tracking. The mobile aspects of Workday allows state employees to access Workday remotely to perform time tracking and absence requests.

By using Workday, all agencies within the state will be able to remotely complete year-end financial statements and audits entirely, as well as easily create work tags for COVID-19, or any other emergencies, for FEMA reimbursement reporting that incorporates the necessary data, including payroll and time tracking. Within Workday, Adaptive will allow the normal budget processes to be reviewed and quickly changed to an alternative forecasting method to better manage emergency impacts, like Covid-19 on operational budgets. Workday also allows the State to grant access to Workday data and reports to external auditors, minimizing the time required by internal staff to support auditor requests which makes the process more efficient during periods of time where working remotely is required.
