My husband, Robert has been gone for over 20 years and his last words to me were Take care of the Farm.

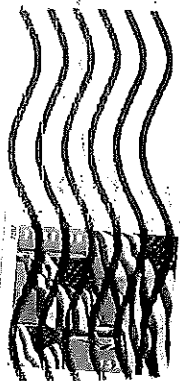

Dear Members of the Iowa Utilities Board:

I am writing as a long-term Story County resident who is concerned about the proposed CO2 pipelines.

Firstly, I believe it is crucial that people are prepared for the meeting you have scheduled for August 22, 2023. The timing is not convenient for many of the people affected, but that issue can no longer be addressed. Given the proposed date, please provide people who wish to attend with the information they need to make plans. What is the agenda? In what order will items be discussed? When and how do people sign up to testify? How are you planning to respond to such requests? What do people need to know in advance in order to be prepared as you want them to be in order to have efficient meetings? If you cannot inform people who wish to attend in a timely fashion, then you should delay the hearings.

Secondly, the issue of eminent domain is highly fraught. Its use must be predicated on a clear public benefit. But the companies building the pipelines and asking that eminent domain be applied are not public, governmental entities. They are for private profit aimed at maximizing the benefit of tax credits. These are not long-standing companies; they are instead formed for the express purpose of generating those benefits, which, by the way, hurt the rest of us as the tax credits the investors gain mean the rest of the citizenry must pay more in taxes or forego reduction in government services. The proposed pipelines will cause environmental degradation and create dangers that private entities will bear and other private investors will benefit from. That is not a public good; it is instead a redistribution of wealth from private citizens to selected, privileged, wealthier private citizens. Unlike roads or schools or parks, the use of these pipelines is not open to the public. Therefore, the government should not yield its power and authority to private entities in this instance.

Finally, climate change and its horrific consequences become ever more salient during this catastrophic heat wave. I question why the Federal government is encouraging the use of more ethanol at a time when we should be moving more strongly towards renewables and away from fossil fuels, which ethanol supplements but does not replace. Will Ethanol even be a thing in 15 years? I rather doubt it and am unhappy that the Federal government is encouraging it in the interim before the country can go more fully towards non-fossil-fuel-reliant vehicles.

In closing, please provide information that people hoping to attend need in a timely fashion. Barring that, please delay the hearings, and please be prepared once the meetings are held to deny the use of eminent domain in the interest of the well-being of humans on this good earth. The recent Canadian forest fires demonstrate that climate problems do not stop at borders we take seriously.
