

Judicial Retention Additions to First Report

Please find below Additional Judges to add to the “Standing for Retention”, list on the Nov 5, 2024 Ballot. These judges will appear on the ballot prior to those from District 6. Starting at the top of the 2nd page of the ballot. The following Judges should be retained or expelled from the courts. The 5 parameters used on the District 6 Judges was used here as well

Supreme Court Justis David May, 1) Appointed by Kim Reynolds, 2) NP, 3) No primary election history, 4) No political party donations found, 5) Voted in two cases at the Supreme court level to defend the Fetal Heartbeat Bills and stop abortions.

My opinion here is to **retain** Justis May **Vote yes**.

Appeals Judge Tyler Buller, 1) Appointed by Kim Reynolds, 2) NP, 3) Voted Dem in three out of the last 4 primaries prior to his Appointment, 4) Donated to four Democratic PACS 5) No Decisions related to Right to life.

My Opinion here is Judge Buller should not be retained **Vote No**.

Appeals Judge Mary Chicchelly,. 1) Appointed by Kim Reynolds, 2) Registered Republican, 3) Primary Election History Voted Republican in 2022 Primary. 4) **Two Donations to Democratic Candidates** and one Nonpartisan Pac 5) No Decisions related to right to life. (This is a tuff call due to her being registered Rep, but donating to democrats makes me lean to a no vote, let your conscience (be your guide here).

My Opinion is due to Judge Chicchelly, “Left leaning”, donations, she should not be retained and is a **vote No**.

Appeals Judge Samuel Langholz,. 1) Appointed by Kim Reynolds, 2) Registered Republican, 3) Voted Republican in the last six primary elections 4) Fifteen donations to republican candidates and nine to Republican PACs. 5) Voted to place a 24 hour “cooling off period” prior to allowing a mother to abort a child.

My opinion here is Judge Langholz should be retained **Vote Yes**

Appeals Judge Mary Ellen Tabor, 1) Appointed by Chet Culver, 2) Registered Democrat, 3) Voted Dem in the last six Primary elections, 4) Donated to three Dem Candidates, 5) no Cases pertaining to Right to life.

My opinion here is Judge Tabor, should not be retained **Vote No**.
