This weekend, my Senate Republican colleagues and I are working around the clock to pass legislation that will restore safety and prosperity for generations of Americans. The One Big Beautiful Bill will stop a \$4 trillion tax increase – the largest tax hike in U.S. history – set to take effect on December 31st if Congress doesn't take action. We're working hard to get this bill to President Trump's desk and ensure hardworking Americans keep more of their hard-earned money.

As Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Committee, I welcomed the Supreme Court's ruling clarifying that federal courts don't have the authority to issue universal injunctions. The ruling confirms what I've repeatedly reminded lowans during my annual county meetings: judges are meant to decide cases and controversies, *not* set nationwide policy from the bench. This is a significant step toward restoring constitutional boundaries the lower courts have breached in recent years, and a victory for checks and balances.

lowans across the state have contacted me about delayed mail delivery and rising postage rates. Families and businesses are being left waiting on important bills and deliveries. In response to lowans' outreach, I wrote to the United States Postal Service (USPS) outlining my concerns and urging improvements. USPS has a constitutional responsibility to serve every community – urban and rural alike – and I applaud the hardworking postal workers who help fulfill that mission.
