Last week, the U.S. Senate unanimously passed my Ending Unemployment Payments to Jobless Millionaires Act as an amendment to the One Big Beautiful Bill, saving taxpayers \$100 million over the next decade. My bill ends the backwards practice of forcing small businesses and job creators to foot the bill for unemployment benefits for those making more than \$1 million annually.
