

Dear Objection Panel:

I am hereby filing an objection to the candidacy of Lisa Ossian in Senate District 44. The nomination petitions Ms. Ossian submitted fail to contain 100 valid signatures as required by Iowa Code section 45.1(4).

1. I am authorized to file this objection under Iowa Code section 43.24(1)(a) since I am a "person who would have the right to vote for the candidate for the office in question...."
2. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), a "signature line shall not be counted if the line lacks the signature of the eligible elector and the signer's residential address, with street and number, if any, and city. A signature line shall not be counted if an eligible elector supplies only a partial address or a post office box address, or if the signer's address is obviously outside the boundaries of the district." Pursuant to Iowa Code section 4.1(3) the "word 'shall' imposes a duty." I have attached a number of examples that show the nomination papers filed by Ms. Ossian failed to meet this statutory duty.
3. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 43.24(1)(a), "Objections to the legal sufficiency of a nomination petition or certificate of nomination filed or issued under this chapter or to the eligibility of a candidate may be filed in writing by any person who would have the right to vote for the candidate for the office in question. Objections relating to incorrect or incomplete information for information that is required under section 43.14 or 43.18 shall be sustained." This objection is being made as there is "incorrect or incomplete information for information that is required under section 43.14."
4. Based on the requirements in Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), the attached pages expressly reflect that Ms. Ossian has failed in her duty to comply with the requirements of the statute and has not submitted 100 valid signatures. Therefore, the Panel should vote to prevent her from appearing on the ballot in Senate District 44.

4. In looking at Exhibit J, line 7, the address listed is not legible however the city, Sigourney, clearly is. If you search the signatures name on the Keokuk County Beacon search page, an address of “221 E Skillman Street, Sigourney” comes up and it clearly shows that Sigourney is in Keokuk County, NOT Mahaska County as is listed on the Nomination Petition form. Further, Sigourney is the County seat of Keokuk County, so clearly there is no way, even with an address that is not legible, that this address is in Mahaska County thus the signature must be discarded.

In looking at Exhibit J, line 8, If you search the address “ 616 N Oak St, Richland” the Keokuk County Beacon search page clearly shows that Richland is located in Keokuk County, NOT Mahaska County as is listed on the Nomination Petition form. This signature is not a resident of Mahaska County as the form states, thus the signature must be discarded.



When that address is searched for on the Jefferson County Assessor page, the correct city is Lockridge. Therefore the address provided is only a partial address and shall not be counted.

When that address is searched for on the Jefferson County Assessor page, the correct city is Lockridge. Therefore the address provided is only a partial address and shall not be counted.

Rather, they use ditto marks which does not satisfy the requirement of Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), a "signature line shall not be counted if the line lacks the.....city". However even if an argument was to be made to accept these ditto marks, because the city prior to it should have been Lockridge, the city with the ditto marks would have had an incorrect city as well and this signature should be removed.
10. In looking at exhibit G, line 3, the city is not listed. Rather, they use ditto marks which does not satisfy the requirement of Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), a "signature line shall not be counted if the line lacks the.....city". However even if an argument was to be made to accept these ditto marks, because the only city listed prior was an incorrect, the city with the ditto marks would have had an incorrect city as well and this signature should be removed.
11. In looking at exhibit G, line 4, the city is not listed. 15. Looking at exhibit F, line 4, the city listed is "FF". In reviewing the Jefferson County Accessor web site, there are no cities in Jefferson County named "FF". Even if "FF" was the abbreviation of some other town, without a zip code listed, mail would not get delivered to this address. In addition, there is no residence with "102 W. Grimes, Fairfield" address. And after searching the signatures name, no properties have been found in Jefferson County. With an incomplete city listed and a nonexistent House number and Street, this signature should be removed.
16. Looking at exhibit M, line 2, the city listed is "Ooko". In reviewing the Mahaska County Accessor web site, there are no cities in Mahaska County named "Ooko". Even if "Ooko" was the abbreviation of some other town, without a zip code listed, mail would not get delivered to this address. With an incomplete city listed, this signature should be removed.
17. Looking at exhibit M, line 9, the city listed is "Oskey". In reviewing the Mahaska County Accessor web site, there are no cities in Mahaska County named "Oskey". Even if "Oskey" was the abbreviation of some other town, without a zip code listed, mail would not get delivered to this address. With an incomplete city listed, this signature should be removed.
18. Looking at exhibit M, line 10, the city listed is "Oskey". In reviewing the Mahaska County Accessor web site, there are no cities in Mahaska County named "Oskey". Even if "Oskey" was the abbreviation of some other town, without a zip code listed, mail would not get delivered to this address. With an incomplete city listed, this signature should be removed.
19. In looking at exhibit M, line 11, the House Number and Street nor is the city listed. Rather, they use ditto marks which does not satisfy the requirement of Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), a " signature line shall not be counted if the line lacks the the signer's residential address, with street and number, if any, and city. A signature line shall not be counted if an eligible elector supplies only a partial address" However even if an argument was to be made to accept these ditto marks, because the city listed prior was an incorrect, the city with the ditto marks would have had an incorrect city as well and this signature should be removed.
20. In looking at exhibit M, line 12, no city is listed. Rather, they use ditto marks which does not satisfy the requirement of Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), a " signature line

shall not be counted if the line lacks the the signer's residential address, with the city. A signature line shall not be counted if an eligible elector supplies only a partial address" However even if an argument was to be made to accept these ditto marks, because the city listed prior was an incorrect, the city with the ditto marks would have had an incorrect city as well and this signature should be removed.

21. Looking at exhibit M, line 13, the city listed is "Oskey". In reviewing the Mahaska County Assessor web site, there are no cities in Mahaska County named "Oskey". Even if "Oskey" was the abbreviation of some other town, without a zip code listed, mail would not get delivered to this address. With an incomplete city listed, this signature should be removed.
22. Looking at exhibit L, line 10, the city listed is "Keo". In reviewing the Van Buren County Assessor web site, there are no cities in Van Buren County named "Keo". Even if "Keo" was the abbreviation of some other town, without a zip code listed, no mail would ever get delivered to this address. Further, in Senate District 44, there are several jurisdictions in different counties, that could be referred to as "Keo". Keota, Keomah, Keokuk, and Keosauqua to name a few. With an incomplete city listed, this signature should be removed.
23. Looking at exhibit L, line 11, the city listed is "Keo". In reviewing the Van Buren County Assessor web site, there are no cities in Van Buren County named "Keo". Pursuant to Iowa Code section 43.14(2)(c), a "signature line shall not be counted if the line lacks the signature of the eligible elector". Thus, this signature should be removed.




