Ob-GynPAC Splits with Miller-Meeks, Endorses Bohannon

After supporting Miller-Meeks in 2022 and 2024, political arm of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) endorses Christina Bohannon in 2026 race

Iowa City, IA – Today, Ob-GynPAC announces its support of Christina Bohannon for Iowa's 1st District. The endorsement is a major loss for Rep. Miller-Meeks, who had their support last cycle. The change signals strong disapproval of the incumbent's healthcare voting record this past year and a lack of faith in her electoral chances in November. Ob-GynPAC is the only federal PAC dedicated exclusively to electing representatives who support obstetrics and gynecology, and is the [political arm](#) of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG).

Johnson County OB/Gyn physician Andrea Greiner, MD, MHA, and Member of Ob-GynPAC, said:

“Ob-GynPAC is supporting Christina Bohannon in November 2026 for Iowa's 1st District Representative. For the past two election cycles, Ob-GynPAC has endorsed Mariannette Miller-Meeks, but enough is enough. Miller-Meeks broke her promise to Iowa obstetricians and gynecologists with her vote for devastating cuts to Medicaid. This undermines OB-GYN care at a time when Iowa hospitals are ending their birthing services, reducing access to care for Iowans, and worsening maternity care deserts. Miller-Meeks makes Iowa's healthcare crisis worse. Christina Bohannon will be the leader we deserve – Christina will fight for access to quality healthcare and support Iowa's dedicated medical professionals. Ob-GynPAC is proud to support Christina in this race because we know she will be a tireless advocate for quality healthcare for all Iowans.”

The endorsement follows Rep. Miller-Meeks's vote to cut Medicaid for over 100,000 Iowans – which also threatens rural hospitals and nursing homes – as well as her vote against ACA tax credits that has caused Iowans' premiums to skyrocket. While hospitals and birthing centers across Southeast Iowa reduce their services or face closure, including [Southeast Iowa Regional Medical Center](#) in Fort Madison and [Henry County Health Center](#) in Wayland, Miller-Meeks has taken over \$600,000 in campaign contributions from Big Pharma and the insurance industry and consistently votes their way.

Iowa's 1st Congressional District contains the cities of Davenport, Iowa City, Burlington, and Indianola. Rep. Mariannette Miller-Meeks faces a rematch against Christina Bohannon, who came within 0.2% of defeating the incumbent in 2024. Bohannon lost by just 799 votes out of 413,000 and outperformed the top of the ticket by over 8 points – more than any other Red-to-Blue candidate in the country. National forecasters, including the Cook Political Report, universally rate this district as a [Toss-Up](#) for 2026. With Rep. Miller-Meeks showing historic weakness at just 31% favorability and facing growing opposition even within her own party, Bohannon has the best opportunity to flip a Republican seat in the country.
